FUN FACTS ABOUT ST ANTHONY

He was born in Lisbon, Portugal in 1195 with the name of Ferdinand. He was the eldest son of an influential family. His parents had great plans for him, and so they arranged for a proper early education. They wanted him to be successful according to the standards of the world; and to further the good fortunes of his family. But he only wanted to respond to the call of the Lord. So, at age 15 he went to live in the Augustinian Abbey of St Vincent on the outskirts of Lisbon. Then went to the Augustinian Abbey of the Holy Cross in Coimbra, where he was ordained to the priesthood at age 25.
